ELECTION DAY IS NOVEMBER 5

To vote, you need to be registered!

Apply online
elections.virginia.gov/citizen-portal

OR

fill out a registration form and turn it into
your state or local government office.

The final day to register is November 4th

WHAT YOU NEED TO VOTE

An Acceptable ID

Examples include:

- Virginia DMV-issued driver's license or ID card
- United States Passport
- Student or Employer ID
- Voter Confirmation Documents

WAYS TO VOTE

By Mail:

Request ballot by October 25, 2024
elections.virginia.gov/absentee

In Person before Election Day:

Vote early at your local registration office
September 20 - November 2, 2024

In Person on Election Day:

Vote at your local polling place on
Tuesday, November 5, 2024

ACCOMMODATIONS

You have the right to accommodations to help you vote. Examples include:

- Magnifiers for reading ballots
- Accessible parking and entrances
- Accessible voting booths
- Voting from your car
- Talking ballots or electronic ballots
- Help reading or marking your ballot
