

# To vote, you need to be registered!

Apply online <u>elections.virginia.gov/citizen-portal</u>
OR

fill out a registration form and turn it into your state or local government office.

The final day to register is November 4th

## WHAT YOU NEED TO VOTE

#### An Acceptable ID

Examples include:

- Virginia DMV-issued driver's license or ID card
- United States Passport
- Student or Employer ID
- Voter Confirmation Documents

# By Mail:

Request ballot by October 25, 2024 <u>elections.virginia.gov/absentee</u>

## In Person before Election Day:

Vote early at your local registration office September 20 - November 2, 2024

# In Person on Election Day:

Vote at your local polling place on **Tuesday, November 5, 2024**Find your polling place <u>elections.virginia.gov/VoterInfo</u>



# **ACCOMMODATIONS**

You have the right to accommodations to help you vote. Examples include:

- Magnifiers for reading ballots
- Accessible parking and entrances
- Accessible voting booths
- Voting from your car
- Talking ballots or electronic ballots
- Help reading or marking your ballot
  - You can bring someone to help you!
